

Dear Student:

The Office of Admissions has informed us of your acceptance into our two-year Associate Degree Nursing Program. We are very pleased to welcome you to Finger Lakes Community College and to the Nursing Program. It is imperative that you **pay close attention to all information contained in this letter.**

1. For those of you who were not eligible to pre-register for the Fall semester, it is important that you follow the instructions in the portfolio you received from the Admissions Office in order to register. Nursing faculty will be present for advisement.
2. Your Health History and Immunization forms must be completed and sent to Student Health Services at FLCC by the date indicated in your Admission Packet. **Failure to comply with the immunization and physical exam requirements may result in your being de-registered.**
3. A four-day course – GST 141-Basic Math Concepts for Nurses – will be offered during the summer for students who would like to brush up on their math skills which will be needed for medication dosage calculations. Students will receive one (1) elective credit upon successful completion of this course.
4. Current CPR certification is required for all clinical courses. The certification must be current at the beginning of each semester and must not expire before the end of each semester's clinical rotation. Only the following CPR course will meet this requirement:
  - ❖ **BLS for the Health Care Provider** offered by the American Heart Association
5. You must purchase the NUR 100 outline, appendix and clinical packet at the Bookstore. They should be available by August. Required textbooks, which you will also need to purchase, are listed in the course outline. **You must bring the NUR 100 outline, appendix and clinical packet with you the first day of class.** You do not need to bring your textbook to class.
6. Enclosed is information where you may purchase your **uniform** and which you must have ordered by **August 3, 2009**. Also enclosed are guidelines pertaining to students' dress code for clinical.

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7. You will not be assigned to an area hospital until the end of September but will be required to attend class on campus during this time. Please be aware that you will need to provide your own transportation to clinical.
8. The schedule for the first week of class will depend on which section of NUR 100 for which you are registered. Pay close attention to your section #:
