

2023-2024 Summer Loan Application



To be considered for summer financial aid you must be matriculated at FLCC and maintaining satisfactory academic progress for financial aid. Upon conclusion of the spring term, your academic eligibility for future aid will be determined. If it is determined that you are academically ineligible, you will be notified on or about May 26, 2023, and you will be responsible for payment of your summer courses. Students from other colleges taking summer courses at FLCC should contact the Financial Aid Office at their home institution to determine if they qualify for financial aid.

Important: To be considered for financial aid for the summer 2023, you must have completed your 2023-2024 FAFSA. Before you can request a student loan for summer, you must be registered to attend at least half-time (6 or more credit hours). Disbursements of financial aid will occur after classes begin. Please budget accordingly.

Important information to consider when requesting a student loan:

- Borrow Responsibly. Never borrow more than you need.
- Summer Loans are part of your annual loan limit. Borrowing during the summer will decrease the amount available to you during the fall and spring semesters.
- If you are graduating at the end of the summer your eligibility for federal student loans will be prorated by the Financial Aid Office when your loan request is processed.
- Freshman students may apply for a maximum of \$5,500 annually, or up to \$1,834 for the summer.
- Sophomores (completed 32 or more credit hours) may apply for a maximum of \$6,500 annually, or up to \$2166 for summer.
- Independent freshman students may apply for up to \$9,500 annually, or \$3,167 for the summer.
- Independent sophomores may apply for up to \$10,500 annually, or \$3,500 for the summer.
