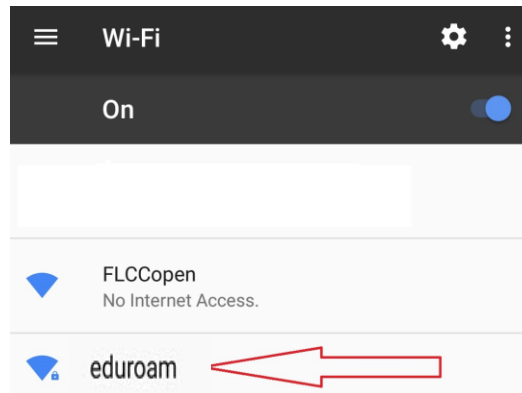


Connecting to eduroam with Android Phones

1) Select the eduroam network from the available networks list
