Applicants seeking entry into the FLCC A.A.S. Nursing program have several admission options based on academic history, course completion, GPA, and other factors. Use the guide below to find the option that best fits your experience and background.

1. Healthcare Studies Direct Entry – Beginning Spring 2025

3. Admission with TEAS Exam – Beginning Fall 2025

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (**TEAS**) exam is a standardized test that evaluates readiness for programs in the health sciences, including nursing.

Scores are good for two years from the application deadline date. Retesting is permitted once, and we encourage you to wait 30 days between testing attempts.
