Policy Statement

Finger Lakes Community College shall allow for the operation of an ROTC program on the campus and shall not create policies that are designed to impair the work of an ROTC program. Military recruiters shall have access to campus employment facilities and services and to directory information. The college may assess a fee to provide directory information.

Reason for Policy

This policy ensures compliance with NYS Education Law granting military recruiters the ability to access campus employment facilities, services and directory information.

Applicability of the Policy

This policy applies to all College personnel who may receive requests for access to campus, access to students on campus or access to directory information or requests relating to ROTC programs on the College campus.
